New Orphan Home – The new home is close to completion with interior plastering ongoing. The plan is for the existing orphans to relocate to this home and for the new girls to occupy the original home. This transition will take place in January if money is available for furnishings.



Central Water System – A new water tower is being erected on the campus to provide a central system for all facilities on the campus. The tower structure has been erected and we are waiting on the rain to let up to allow the tanks to be lifted into place.



Central Septic System – A design and cost estimate is being made for a new central Septic System. More next quarter.
