Partners in Mission exists to educate, equip and support the people of the UMC Texas Annual Conference in response to the invitation of local, national and international Methodist churches in partnership through hands on ministry. Partners in Mission will be going July 20 to August 5, 2012 to the Providence Children's Home (PCH) campus near Nairobi, Kenya.

### Providence Children's Home

PCH supports and cares for children whose parents have died of HIV/AIDS. The campus sits in the Ngong Hills on 15 acres near Matasia, Kenya and consists of an existing Pre-K-12 school, an orphanage and a community health clinic. The first of the planned additional orphan houses is nearing completion.

PCH is raising money to build more homes for these children and we have plans to eventually provide homes for 400 children. Our partners in Kenya are also raising money locally. With your help and involvement, we will reach our goal.

Our team is forming and we will be doing some construction work at the site, as well as utilizing the gifts of all participants. There is need for teacher workshops, medical and dental teams, and any life skill instructions.

### Preliminary Itinerary

- July 20-21 – Travel to Kenya
- July 22 - Worship- possibly with the girls
- July 23-July 28 - Work at the project (possibly take a day trip or 2 with the girls)
- July 29 - Worship- some free time locally
- July 30-31- Work at project
- August 1-3 – Activities with orphan girls (Optional safari dates)
- August 4-5 - Travel back to U.S.
